Overall, the Build Alternative effects on stormwater runoff would be beneficial due to the incorporation of appropriate stormwater management design and reduction in impervious surfaces.

Negligible decrease of 0.04% regional vehicle miles traveled/greenhouse gas emissions/energy consumption compared to No Build. Energy consumption and emissions from tunnel systems, including lighting and ventilation.

No permanent effects on hazardous waste and contaminated materials other than construction-related abatement that would remove some existing hazardous waste or contaminated materials.

Potential increases in household wealth, tax revenues, and infill development resulting from potential increases in property values. Improved access to community services and local businesses.

*Additional topics evaluated include social groups benefitted or harmed, air quality, wetlands, waterways, groundwater, general ecology, threatened and endangered species, asbestos and lead and traffic and transportation.
