

Measures That Would Minimize Air Quality Effects

- Greenspace and tree planting
 - Planting of trees in front of the residential properties adjacent to the portals.
 - Realignment of Humboldt Parkway north of Sidney Street to accommodate tree planting.
 - Planting of low growing shrubs (“vegetative buffer”) in the greenspace immediately adjacent to the portals, with fencing to restrict public access for safety reasons.
 - Planting of low growing trees adjacent to the fencing.
 - Incorporate plantings into the design of retaining walls near the tunnel portals.



Health benefits of trees and greenspace

1. Remove particulate matter
2. Encourage physical activity
3. Temperature /heat island reduction
4. Psychological benefits
